Pray for the role of The Way We Care leads in each of the homes, that they would be inspired and creative in helping this special approach become deeply embedded in the culture of the homes.

Pray that those visiting the home, whether relatives, volunteers or representatives from the Care Quality Commission (CQC), would be helped to

understand the value of this approach and would be encouraged as they see it in action.

Please pray for more opportunities for important and significant relationships to grow within these communities so that no one who lives with us is lonely. Pray that more people who would benefit from these communities would come and live with us.

Please pray for those who lead our housing work and who provide valued extra support to those living independently. Please pray for more people to come and work with us in this important area.

### Friday 16th June: The Growth and Renewal Programme

The Growth and Renewal Programme is our commitment to see our capacity to care for older people continue to grow. We thank God for the successful opening and establishing of Middlefields House in Chippenham which has thrived over the last two years.

Please pray for plans to build a new home on the South Coast where we have struggled to find the right land so far. Pray that God would make clear what the right path is for our plans on the South Coast and a way would be made to keep providing great Christian care there. Pray for the investments that we're continuing to make in our other buildings

to ensure that they are always able to provide the right physical environments for our communities.

Please also pray for those care homes and housing schemes across the UK who share Pilgrims' Friend Society's faith and values but who need more support with their operations. Please pray for conversations between

the charity and others, that great partnership would be easily identified, and the right decisions would be made for all involved.

## Saturday 17th June: Giving and finance

We are thankful to God for His bountiful provision over more than 200 years but as costs increase our need for financial support continues. Thank God for all that He has provided over the years and for the generosity of those who give to the work.

Please also pray that challenges in funding social care would be adequately addressed by the Governement so that Local Authorities are able to pay for the true cost of care. Pray that courageous leadership in this area would become a hallmark of government in the coming years.

Please pray that more people would be inspired to give generously to our work, especially through regular giving such as standing orders and Direct Debits which help us to plan well. Pray that people would take up the opportunity to take part in our sponsored pilgrimage this summer.

Thank God for those who leave legacies in their will which ensures the care of older people long after the giver has gone to glory. Pray that others would consider this way of giving to the work.
